


Board of Realty Regulation

General License Information for Real Estate Salesperson

YOU MUST PASS THE TEST BEFORE MAKING APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE

In the State of Montana, a person may not engage in or conduct business in the capacity of a real estate salesperson, until that person has received from the Montana Board of Realty Regulation a license.



The following outlines general licensing information for Real Estate Salesperson. For specific information on filing an application, you will need to obtain the application, which includes a detailed listing of the requirements.

A. Licensing Fees:

\$87.50 \$35.00 Recovery Account (one time fee)

B. Education Requirements:

High school graduation or equivalent; <u>60 Hours of additional pre-licensing instruction</u> from a school and instructor approved by the Board.

C. Experience Requirements: None

D. Examination Information:

Pass the Montana Real Estate Examination with a score of 80% or better the uniform and
